Pricing

To date, we do not have specific pricing information as it is not public. However, JobRouter offers a basic platform with a number of features, all of which are priced separately as modules.

This can add up quickly if you want to cover more than the basics.

Main Weaknesses

Pricing: The modular pricing structure, while offering flexibility, poses a potential disadvantage as expenses can quickly accumulate when purchasing multiple modules separately, increasing the overall cost of ownership and potentially making it cost-prohibitive for smaller organizations or those on tight budgets.

Document-/data workflows: Originating from its roots in document management, JobRouter places a strong emphasis on data-centric and document-driven workflows.

No BPMN support: The lack of native support for BPMN is a drawback, as users have to learn their proprietary modelling notation from scratch. In addition, existing BPMN process models must be converted, and there is usually no way back.

Lack of process management approach: JobRouter does not support typical process management capabilites, like process landscapes, process portal and process documentation. They are only focussing on automation.

Difficult learning experience: Requires programming experience to cover all aspects and use cases.

Summary

JobRouter, while offering automation solutions, presents several notable drawbacks that may hinder its appeal to certain users. Firstly, its modular pricing structure, although providing flexibility, can lead to substantial expenses as users add multiple modules separately, potentially rendering it cost-prohibitive for smaller organizations or those with limited budgets. Originating from its foundation in document management, JobRouter prioritizes data-centric and document-driven workflows, which may not fully align with the needs of organizations with diverse or less document-intensive processes. Moreover, the lack of native support for BPMN poses a significant disadvantage, requiring users to learn a proprietary modeling notation and navigate the complexities of converting existing BPMN process models. Additionally, JobRouter's focus on automation overlooks typical process management capabilities such as process landscapes and documentation, limiting its utility for comprehensive process management needs. Lastly, mastering JobRouter may prove challenging for users without programming experience, potentially slowing down implementation and customisation processes.
